5	completed its 2013-2014 season by competing at the 2014 International Public Debate
6	Association (IPDA) national championship tournament; and
7	WHEREAS, the 2013-2014 BPCC debate team was comprised of Natalie Banks,
8	Erika Hill, Prince Lofton, and David Tillmon; and
9	WHEREAS, the team returned from the IPDA tournament with impressive honors
10	in tow; and
11	WHEREAS, Team Captain Erika Hill finished her 2013-2014 season in the varsity
12	division of debate ranked as the number one community college student in the nation; and
13	WHEREAS, novice division debater Prince Lofton finished the year ranked as the
14	number three ranked community college student; and
15	WHEREAS, beginning in 2006, the IPDA began honoring a "Coach of the Year"
16	each year, and three years later the organization renamed the award the Bennett Strange
17	Coach of the Year, in honor of the late Bennett Strange, who coached the Louisiana College
18	debate team from 1988 to 2006 and taught for a semester at BPCC in 2006; and
19	WHEREAS, BPCC debate coach Bob Alexander was named the Bennett Strange
20	Coach of the Year at the IPDA's annual awards banquet held on Sunday, April 13, 2014, at

1 Middle Tennessee State University, becoming the first coach from a community college to

- 5 four championships competing against programs from such well-known schools as Texas
