SENATE BILL NO. 589

BY SENATOR WALSWORTH

CHILDREN. Extends the termination date of the Children's Cabinet. (gov sig)

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AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 46:2607, relative to the Children's Cabinet; to provide relative to the termination date; to provide for an effective date; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 46:2607 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§2607. Termination

The existence of the Children's Cabinet shall terminate, all legal authority therefor shall cease, and this Chapter shall be repealed on August 15, ~~2014~~ **2018**.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.

Walsworth (SB 589)

Present law provides the existence of the Children's Cabinet shall terminate on August 15, 2014.

Proposed law amends present law to provide the existence of the Children's Cabinet shall terminate on August 15, 2018.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
