## Thompson (SB 129)

<u>Present law</u> provides for the licensing and regulation of manufacturers, dealer-distributors, users, blasters, and handlers of explosives by the deputy secretary for public safety services of the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but adds provision that authorizes the department to inspect all facilities under the control of an explosives licensee when the license is issued pursuant to state law.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires, that in addition to compliance with state law, each manufacturer, dealer-distributor, and user of explosives also possess a valid explosives license or permit from the U.S. Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives.

Effective upon signature of governor (April 23, 2014).
