**HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS**

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Health and Welfare to Original House Bill No. 249 by Representative Price

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 3, line 7, after "2015," delete the remainder of the line and delete line 8 in its  
3 entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

4 "authorizes the same services for families experiencing homelessness as for other  
5 low-income families. However, the plan does not account for the ways that  
6 eligibility requirements for homeless families function as a barrier which restricts  
7 those families from ultimately receiving assistance."

8 AMENDMENT NO. 2

9 On page 3, line 23, delete "prioritization of"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 3

11 On page 3, at the end of line 24, insert "assistance"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 4

13 On page 4, delete lines 4 and 5 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

14 "(2) Establish a grace period of a defined duration in which a homeless  
15 family is authorized to receive subsidized child care and to enroll a child in such care  
16 pending submission of necessary entry documentation. The purpose of the grace  
17 period shall be to allow the family reasonable time to comply with requirements to  
18 submit a birth certificate and immunization records."

19 AMENDMENT NO. 5

20 On page 4, line 8, after "program" and before the period "." insert "for a period of not less  
21 than ninety days from the date of their child's enrollment in child care"
