2	To urge and request the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries to study and make
3	recommendations to alleviate problems accessing the Pearl and Bogue Chitto rivers.
4	WHEREAS, accessibility of the state's great waterways is important to recreational
5	and commercial interests; and
6	WHEREAS, low head dams on the Pearl and Bogue Chitto rivers have restricted
7	boater access for more than fifty-seven years; and
8	WHEREAS, in an effort to improve accessibility and safety, the Louisiana
9	Department of Wildlife and Fisheries and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers should
10	collaborate on adding and upgrading boat launch sites as well as providing better access to
11	the waterways; and
12	WHEREAS, any workable plan should include efforts to maximize boater access and
13	utilization of the Pearl and Bogue Chitto rivers.
14	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
15	urge and request the Department of Wildlife and Fisheries to study and make detailed
16	recommendations in a report to improve boater accessibility in the Pearl and Bogue Chitto
17	rivers.
