

1 extender of credit, may charge the fee for credit investigation, compliance with
 2 federal and state law, preparation of the documents necessary to perfect or satisfy a
 3 lien upon the objects sold, and any other functions incidental to the titling of the
 4 retail sale." The disclosure shall be printed on the bill of sale, buyer's order, or sales
 5 contract which is signed by the buyer and retained by the buyer and seller.

7 Section 2. R.S. 6:969.18(G) is hereby repealed in its entirety.

8 Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
 9 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
 10 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
 11 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
 12 effective on the day following such approval.
