WHEREAS, internal auditing as a career offers job opportunities with attractive salaries, challenge, prestige, and professional certification as a Certified Internal Auditor.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby recognize May 2014 as "International Internal Audit Awareness Month" in the Senate.
