1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "R.S. 33:1992(A)(1)" delete "and 2002(A)(3)(a)," and insert a  
3 comma "," and "2002(A)(3)(a), 2490(E), and 2550(E),"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 2, after "relative to" delete the remainder of the line and at the beginning of  
6 line 3, delete "for"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, line 3, after "firefighters;" and before "to provide" insert "to provide relative to  
9 the minimum wage paid to firefighters;"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 1, line 5, after "Act;" and before "and to" insert "to provide relative to the  
12 reinstatement, reemployment, and seniority of firefighters who retire or resign due to an  
13 injury;"

14 AMENDMENT NO. 5

15 On page 1, line 7, after "R.S. 33:1992(A)(1) and before "are hereby" delete "and  
16 2002(A)(3)(a)" and insert a comma "," and "2002(A)(3)(a), 2490(E), and 2550(E)"

17 AMENDMENT NO. 6

18 On page 2, after line 16, insert the following:

19 "§2490. Reinstatement and reemployment

21 E.(1) Any regular employee who resigns or retires from a position in the  
22 classified police service may, with the prior approval of the board, be reemployed  
23 in a position of the class in which he was employed immediately preceding his  
24 resignation or retirement or in a position in any lower class. Any such employee  
25 may be reemployed at any time after his resignation or retirement, but he shall be  
26 qualified for the position to which he is reemployed. In addition, the employee shall  
27 be reemployed with the seniority accumulated through the date of reinstatement;  
28 however, a regular employee shall be reemployed as provided in this ~~Subsection~~  
29 Paragraph only if his resignation or retirement occurred as a result of the employee  
30 being unable to perform the essential functions of his job upon sustaining any injury  
31 that is compensable pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 10 of Title 23 of the  
32 Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950.

33 (2) Any regular employee who resigns or retires from a position in the  
34 classified fire service may, with the prior approval of the board, be reemployed in  
35 a position of the class in which he was employed immediately preceding his

1 resignation or retirement or in a position in any lower class. Any such employee  
2 may be reemployed at any time after his resignation or retirement, but he shall be  
3 qualified for the position to which he is reemployed. In addition, the employee shall
