**HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS**

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Ways and Means to Engrossed Senate Bill No. 110 by Senator Riser

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 2, line 12, after "states" delete the remainder of the line in its entirety, delete lines  
 3 13 through 16 in their entirety and from the beginning of line 17, delete "information." and  
 4 insert the following:

5 **"The secretary, attorney general, and commissioner may share information**  
 6 **received under this Paragraph with the professional services firm or firms**  
 7 **retained for the purpose of calculating the tobacco revenue owed to the state**  
 8 **pursuant to the Master Settlement Agreement executed on November 23, 1998,**  
 9 **as well as any subsequent agreements that may be executed pertaining to the**  
 10 **Master Settlement Agreement. Any information shared or furnished shall be**  
 11 **considered and held to be confidential and privileged by the professional**  
 12 **services firm or firms."**

13 AMENDMENT NO. 2

14 On page 3, after line 1, insert the following:

15 "Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not  
 16 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature  
 17 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If  
 18 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become  
 19 effective on the day following such approval."
