HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Representative Moreno to Reengrossed Senate Bill No. 422 by Senator Broome

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 14, between "person" and "requested" insert "acting in good faith"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 2, line 9, after "for" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 10 through 12
6 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof "any offense related solely to the possession and
7 consumption of alcohol."

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 3, between lines 16 and 17, insert the following:

10 "C.(1) Before administering an opioid antagonist
11 pursuant to this Section, a first responder shall complete the
12 training necessary to safely and properly administer an opioid
13 antagonist to individuals who are undergoing or who are believed
14 to be undergoing an opioid-related drug overdose. The training,
15 at a minimum, shall cover all of the following:

16 (a) Techniques on how to recognize symptoms of an
17 opioid-related overdose.

18 (b) Standards and procedures for the storage and
19 administration of an opioid antagonist.

20 (c) Emergency follow-up procedures."

21 AMENDMENT NO. 4

22 On page 3, at the beginning of line 17, change "C." to "(2)"

23 AMENDMENT NO. 5

24 On page 3, after line 22, insert the following:

25 "D. The deputy secretary of public safety services of the
26 Department of Public Safety and Corrections shall develop and
27 promulgate, in accordance with the Administrative Procedure
28 Act, a set of best practices for use by a fire department or law
29 enforcement agency in the administration and enforcement of
30 this Section including but not limited to the training necessary to
31 safely and properly administer an opioid antagonist to
32 individuals who are undergoing or who are believed to be
33 undergoing an opioid-related drug overdose, the standards and
34 procedures for the storage and administration of an opioid
35 antagonist, and emergency follow-up procedures."
