COMMENDATIONS: Commends the Simsboro High School boys' track and field team for winning the 2014 Class B state championship

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To commend the Simsboro High School boys' track and field team for winning the 2014
3 Class B state championship.

4 WHEREAS, the Louisiana High School Athletic Association Class B and C Track
5 and Field Championships were held on Thursday, May 8, 2014, at the LSU Bernie Moore
6 Track Stadium; and

7 WHEREAS, the Simsboro High School boys' track and field team earned a top team
8 score of 64.5; and

9 WHEREAS, Rontavious Abney was named the state meet MVP and won first place
10 in both the 110m and 300m hurdles, second place in the 160m relay, and fourth place in the
11 800m relay; and

12 WHEREAS, Jeromie Ashley placed fourth in the 400m and the 800m relay, Colton
13 Cochran placed second in the 1600m relay and the 3200m relay, Dequalone James placed
14 second in the 1600m relay and fourth in both the 400m and 800m relays, Dallas Leith placed
15 eighth in the 3200m relay, Cardaye Modest placed third in the 800m relay and second in the
16 1600m relay, Xavier Ogunyemi placed second in the 1600m relay and fourth in the 400m
17 and 800m relays, Matthew Roberson placed eighth in pole vault, and Brandon Walker placed
18 fourth in shot put and ninth in discus; Zach Beard and Brendan Jackson served as relay
19 alternates.

1 WHEREAS, all members of the team performed at the highest level of excellence
2 throughout the entire season, and each of them deserves recognition for his vital contribution
3 to the winning effort; and

4 WHEREAS, the amazing accomplishments of this team could not have been
5 achieved without the guidance and skills of the coaching staff and all of the other individuals
6 who have contributed to the success of the school's track and field program.

7 WHEREAS, the outstanding feats of the team members and coaches of the Simsboro
8 High School boys' track and field team merit a sincere measure of commendation for the
9 pride and honor they have brought to their school and families, the state of Louisiana, and
10 the Simsboro community.

11 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
12 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend the Simsboro High School boys' track and
13 field team for winning the 2014 Class B state championship.
