5 On page 2, line 2, between "such as" and "name" insert "full"

7 On page 2, line 8, between "statistics" and "that relate" insert "and other information"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 2, at the beginning of line 10, change "properties" to "identities"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 5

11 On page 3, line 5, between "provide" and "student" insert "personally identifiable"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 6

13 On page 3, line 7, between "may" and the colon ":" insert ", in accordance with State Board  
14 of Elementary and Secondary Education regulation or applicable state and federal law"

15 AMENDMENT NO. 7

16 On page 3, line 13, after "monitoring." delete the remainder of the line, and at the beginning  
17 of line 14, delete "district", and insert "program administration, and state"

26 reached the age of legal majority, or if the information is provided to a person authorized by  
27 the state, including the legislative auditor, to audit processes including student enrollment

16 AMENDMENT NO. 17

17 On page 5, delete lines 10 through 14, and insert the following:

18 "E.(1) No person who has access to student information shall convert the  
19 student information as specified in Subparagraph (C)(2)(b) of this Section such that  
20 the remaining information can be used to identify a student.

21 (2) The State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education and the state  
22 Department of Education shall not require a city, parish, or other local public school  
23 system to limit a student's learning opportunity or opportunities to explore any  
24 occupation based upon predictive modeling."

26 On page 5, line 16, between "student" and "services" insert "and other education"

27 AMENDMENT NO. 19

28 On page 6, line 6, after "contract" delete the period "." insert "", unless otherwise directed  
29 by an applicable legal requirement or otherwise specified in the contract and subject to the  
30 privacy protection provisions of this Part. Upon termination of the contract, all information  
31 removed from the contractor's servers shall be returned to the city, parish, or other local  
32 public school board."

33 AMENDMENT NO. 20

34 On page 6, line 7, between "who" and "violates" insert "knowingly and willingly"

35 AMENDMENT NO. 21

36 On page 6, between lines 15 and 16, insert the following:

1 "I. The provisions of this Part shall apply to each charter school, its  
2 governing authority, and any education management organization under contract to  
3 operate a charter school.

4 J.(1) No school, school system, local or state governmental agency, public  
5 or private entity, or any person with access to student information shall sell, transfer,  
6 share, or process any student data for use in commercial advertising, or marketing,  
7 or any other commercial purpose.

8 (2) The provisions of Paragraph (1) of this Subsection shall not apply to a  
9 student's parent or legal guardian, or a student who has reached the legal age of  
10 majority.

11 K.(1)Notwithstanding any provision of this Part to the contrary, the  
12 governing authority of each public school, with the permission of a student's parent  
13 or legal guardian, shall collect the following personally identifiable information for  
14 each student enrolled in grades eight through twelve:

- 15 (a) Full name.
- 16 (b) Date of birth.
- 17 (c) Social security number.
- 18 (d) Student transcript data.

19 (2) The governing authority of a public school shall disclose the information  
20 collected pursuant to Paragraph (1) of this Subsection, upon request, only to a  
21 Louisiana postsecondary educational institution, to be used solely for the purpose of  
22 processing applications for admission, and to the Office of Student Financial  
23 Assistance, to be used solely for the purpose of processing applications made to the  
24 office for state and federal financial aid and for required financial aid program  
25 reporting.

26 (3)(a) Beginning in the eighth grade, the governing authority of each public  
27 school shall annually, at the beginning of each school year, provide a form to be  
28 signed by the parent or legal guardian of each student enrolled in the school,  
29 whereby the student's parent or legal guardian may provide consent or deny consent  
30 for the collection and disclosure of the student's information as provided in  
31 Paragraphs (1) and (2) of this Subsection.

32 (b) No data shall be collected pursuant to this Subsection, unless a student's  
33 parent or legal guardian provides written consent.

34 (c) The form will contain a statement whereby a student's parent or legal  
35 guardian acknowledges that failure to provide written consent for the collection and  
36 disclosure of the student's information as provided in this Subsection may result in  
37 delays or may prevent successful application for admission to a postsecondary  
38 educational institution and for state and federal student financial aid.

39 (4) The governing authority of each public school shall destroy all data  
40 collected for purposes of this Subsection not later than three years after the student  
41 graduates from high school."
