SENATE BILL NO. 214

BY SENATORS RISER AND MORRELL

DISTRICT ATTORNEYS. Provides for the omnibus new assistant district attorney positions for various judicial districts in the state. (8/1/14)

AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 16:51(A)(5), (6), (7), (14), (16), (19), (20), (21), (24), (29), (36),
3	and (37), relative to assistant district attorneys; to provide for additional assistant
4	district attorneys for certain judicial districts; to provide for an effective date; and to
5	provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. R.S. 16:51(A)(5), (6), (7), (14), (16), (19), (20), (21), (24), (29), (36), and
8	(37) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
9	§51. Assistant district attorneys
10	A. The district attorney of each judicial district and of the parish of Orleans
11	shall appoint a first assistant district attorney and such other assistant district
12	attorneys for his respective judicial district or for the parish of Orleans as may be
13	necessary, the total number of assistant district attorneys in each judicial district and
14	in the parish of Orleans to be not less than as hereinafter set forth:

16	(5) In the Fifth Judicial District, six seven assistant district attorneys;
17	(6) In the Sixth Judicial District, seven eight assistant district attorneys;

25	Section 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of R.S. 16:11 to the contrary, the
26	provisions of Section 1 of this Act shall become operative if, and only if, Section 1 of this
27	Act is funded from the amount of State General Fund (Direct) or State General Fund by
28	Statutory Dedications contained in House Bill No. 1 of the 2014 Regular Session as received
29	in the Senate on May 12, 2014, or if the source of funding for Section 1 is from local or other

sources to be used to fund such additional assistant district attorney positions.

DIGEST

Riser (SB 214)

<u>Present law</u> provides for the number of assistant district attorneys for the various judicial districts.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the number of assistant district attorneys in particular judicial districts as follows:

- (1) 5^{th} JDC \underline{from} 6 \underline{to} 7.
- (2) 6^{th} JDC from 7 to 8.
- (3) 7th JDC <u>from</u> 5 <u>to</u> 6.
- (4) 14th JDC <u>from</u> 23 <u>to</u> 24.
- (5) 16th JDC <u>from</u> 21 <u>to</u> 22.
- (6) 19th JDC <u>from</u> 48 <u>to</u> 50.
- (7) 20^{th} JDC <u>from</u> 5 <u>to</u> 6.
- (8) 21st JDC <u>from</u> 18 <u>to</u> 19.
- (9) 24th JDC <u>from</u> 52 <u>to</u> 54.
- (10) 29^{th} JDC $\underline{\text{from}}$ 9 $\underline{\text{to}}$ 10.
- (11) 36^{th} JDC <u>from</u> 4 to 5.
- (12) 37th JDC from 2 to 3.

Notwithstanding the provisions of law relative to assistant district attorney salaries, the provisions paying for the additional positions shall become operative if, and only if, such salaries are funded from the amount of State General Fund or Statutory Dedications contained in HB No.1 of the 2014 Regular Session as received in the Senate or if the source of funding is from local or other sources.

Effective August 1, 2014.

<u>Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Finance to the engrossed bill</u>

Notwithstanding the provisions of law relative to assistant district attorney salaries, the provisions paying for the additional positions shall become operative if, and only if, such salaries are funded from the amount of State General Fund or Statutory Dedications contained in HB No.1 of the 2014 Regular Session as received in the Senate or if the source of funding is from local or other sources.
