12 AMENDMENT NO. 4

13 On page 1, between lines 7 and 8, insert the following:

14 "§1118.2. Additional ethical standards; State Board of Elementary and Secondary
15 Education; state superintendent of education; related persons

16 A. If any provision of this Section conflicts with any other provision of this
17 Part, the more restrictive provision shall govern.

18 B.(1) No member of the State Board of Elementary and Secondary
19 Education, member of his immediate family, or legal entity in which such a person
20 has a substantial economic interest shall bid on or enter into or be in any way
21 interested in any contract, subcontract, or other transaction that is under the
22 supervision or jurisdiction of the State Board of Elementary and Secondary
23 Education or the Department of Education. This Subsection shall not be construed
24 to prohibit the employment of any member of the State Board of Elementary and
25 Secondary Education or any member of the immediate family of a member of the
26 State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education by a nonpublic school.

27 (2) No state superintendent of education, member of his immediate family,
28 or legal entity in which such a person has a substantial economic interest shall bid
29 on or enter into or be in any way interested in any contract, subcontract, or other
30 transaction that is under the supervision or jurisdiction of the State Board of
31 Elementary and Secondary Education or the Department of Education.

32 C. No immediate family member of the state superintendent of education or
33 of a member of the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education and no legal
34 entity of which such an immediate family member is an officer, director, trustee,
35 partner, or employee, or in which an immediate family member has a substantial
36 economic interest, shall receive or agree to receive any thing of economic value for
37 assisting a person in a transaction, or in an appearance in connection with a
38 transaction, with the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education or the
39 Department of Education.

1 D.(1) No member of the State Board of Elementary and Secondary
2 Education nor the state superintendent of education shall participate in a transaction
3 in which he has a personal substantial economic interest involving the State Board
4 of Elementary and Secondary Education or the Department of Education.

5 (2) No member of the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education
6 nor the state superintendent of education shall participate in a transaction involving
7 the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education or the Department of
8 Education in which any of the following persons has a substantial economic interest:

9 (a) Any member of his immediate family.

10 (b) Any person in which he has a substantial economic interest.

11 (c) Any person of which he is a member or an officer, director, trustee,
12 partner, or employee.

13 (d) Any person of which his immediate family member is a member or an
14 officer, director, trustee, partner, or employee.

15 (e) Any person with whom he is negotiating or has an arrangement
16 concerning prospective employment.

17 (f) Any person who is a party to an existing contract with such public servant
18 or his immediate family member or with any legal entity in which the public servant
19 or his immediate family member owns a controlling interest.

20 E. No former member of the State Board of Elementary and Secondary
21 Education nor former state superintendent of education shall, for compensation, for
22 a period of two years following the termination of his public service in such position
23 engage in a transaction, assist another person in a transaction, or make an
24 appearance in connection with a transaction involving the State Board of Elementary
25 and Secondary Education or the Department of Education or render any service on
26 a contractual basis to or for the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education
27 or the Department of Education.

28 F. No legal entity in which a former member of the State Board of
29 Elementary and Secondary Education or former state superintendent of education is
30 an officer, director, trustee, partner, or employee shall, for compensation, for a
31 period of two years following the termination of his public service in such position,
32 engage in a transaction, assist another person with a transaction, or make an
33 appearance in connection with a transaction involving the State Board of Elementary
34 and Secondary Education or the Department of Education.

35 G. No member of the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education,
36 state superintendent of education, former member of the State Board of Elementary
37 and Secondary Education, or former state superintendent of education shall share in
38 any thing of economic value received by another person for any activity, action, or
39 assistance which such public servant or former public servant is prohibited from
40 performing by this Part.

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
