1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 In House Committee Amendment No. 1 proposed by the House Committee on Municipal,  
 3 Parochial and Cultural Affairs and adopted by the House of Representatives on May 12,  
 4 2014, on page 1, delete line 3 in its entirety and insert "600.91(A)(29) and to enact R.S.  
 5 40:600.91(A)(30),"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 2

7 Delete House Committee Amendment No. 3 proposed by the House Committee on  
 8 Municipal, Parochial and Cultural Affairs and adopted by the House of Representatives on  
 9 May 12, 2014.

10 AMENDMENT NO. 3

11 On page 1, line 4, after "duties;" and before "and to provide" insert "to require the  
 12 corporation to broadcast and record meetings of the board of directors and the board's  
 13 committees;"

14 AMENDMENT NO. 4

15 On page 1, line 7, after "R.S. 40:600.88" delete the remainder of the line and insert a comma  
 16 "," and "600.90(D), and 600.91(A)(29) are hereby amended and reenacted and R.S.  
 17 40:600.91(A)(30) is hereby enacted"

18 AMENDMENT NO. 5

19 On page 2, between lines 4 and 5, insert the following:

20 "(30)(a) The corporation shall broadcast, over the Internet, live audio and  
 21 video streams of all meetings of the board of directors and the board's committees.

22 (b) The provisions of Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph shall not apply to  
 23 executive sessions held in accordance with the Open Meetings Law.

24 (c) All meetings broadcast in accordance with the provisions of  
 25 Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph shall be recorded, archived, and made accessible  
 26 to the public for at least two years after the date of the meeting.

27 (d) The audio and video records created pursuant to this Paragraph shall not  
 28 be construed in any manner to be the official record or any part of the official record  
 29 of the proceedings of any meeting of the board of directors or any of the board's  
 30 committees."
