

HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS

House Bill No. 126 by Representative Henry Burns

MTR VEHICLE/COMPULS INS: Requires law enforcement officers to check for compliance with the compulsory motor vehicle liability security law during traffic stops

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Provides that proposed law becomes effective when House Bill No. 872 of the 2014 R.S. is enacted and becomes effective.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Present law requires law enforcement officers to determine if the owner or lessee of each motor vehicle stopped at an administrative violations checkpoint, motor vehicle accidents, or in connection with an alleged violation of the law has evidence of the required compulsory motor vehicle liability security contained in the vehicle.

Proposed law retains present law and further requires law enforcement officers to electronically verify, as applicable within his capability, that such documents evidencing that the motor vehicle is compliant are current.

Effective if and when House Bill No. 872 of the 2014 R.S. is enacted and becomes effective.
