1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 Delete Committee Amendments Nos.1 through 11 proposed by the Senate Committee on
3 Judiciary A and adopted by the Senate on May 21, 2014.

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 Delete Amendments Nos. 1 and 2 proposed by the Legislative Bureau and adopted by the
6 Senate on May 22, 2014.

8 On page 1, at the end of line 5, delete "and"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 4

10 On page 1, line 6, after "2519(A)" and before "and" insert ", and Section 1 of Act 277 of the
11 2013 Regular Session of the Louisiana Legislature,"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 5

13 On page 1, line 10, after "court;" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 11 through
14 13 in their entirety and insert "to provide for the creation of a task force to perform a study
15 to provide for recommendations on the number of judges necessary in the municipal and
16 traffic courts of New Orleans, and on methods and procedures to effectuate the consolidation
17 of the New Orleans Traffic Court and the New Orleans Municipal Court; to provide for
18 certain procedures, duties, membership, and reporting deadlines of the task force; to
19 authorize and provide for the transfer of certain state property; to provide for the creation of
20 a committee to make a recommendation regarding certain state property and to provide for
21 its membership; and"

22 AMENDMENT NO. 6

23 On page 19, after line 11, add the following:

24 "Section 11. Section 1 of Act 227 of the 2013 Legislative Session of the Louisiana
25 Legislature is hereby amended and reenacted as follows:

26 Section 1.(A) The commissioner of administration shall have the authority to enter
27 into a cooperative endeavor agreement with the BioDistrict New Orleans to allow the former
28 Louisiana State Supreme Court site and the former state office building site located at 325
29 Loyola Avenue, New Orleans, Louisiana, to be utilized as the new civil district court site or
30 to transfer such site to the city of New Orleans either for the appraised value or in exchange
31 for value equivalent to the appraised value.

32 (B) A committee is hereby created to provide a recommendation to the
33 commissioner of administration regarding the transfer of the property sites provided for in
34 Paragraph A of this Section. The committee shall consist of the following members:

35 (1) Four members from the Division of Administration.

36 (2) One member of the Louisiana House of Representatives whose legislative district
37 includes all or part of Orleans Parish appointed by the governor.

38 (3) One member of the Senate whose legislative district includes all or part of
39 Orleans Parish appointed by the governor.

40 (4) One member of the Senate whose legislative district includes the property
41 located at 325 Loyola Avenue, New Orleans, Louisiana.

1 (5) One member of the Louisiana House of Representatives whose legislative district
2 includes the property located at 325 Loyola Avenue, New Orleans, Louisiana."
