Kostelka (SB 187) Act No. 289

<u>Prior law</u> provided enhanced sentencing for certain violations of <u>prior law</u> (Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law) that occur in drug free zones provided for by <u>prior law</u>. <u>New law</u> retains <u>prior law</u>.

<u>Prior law</u> provided that enhanced sentencing provisions of <u>prior law</u> do not apply to violations that occur entirely within a private residence when no person 17 years of age or under was present.

<u>New law</u> repeals <u>prior law</u> so as to allow enhanced sentencing for violations of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law that occur within a private residence that is located in a drug free zone.

Effective upon signature of the governor (May 28, 2014).
