11	Smiley and Friends Tour" in 2005 and in just a few short years has already performed
12	alongside well-known comedians such as Kevin Hart, Lil' Duval, Rickey Smiley, Mike Epps,
13	DL Hughley, Rodney Perry, Cedric the Entertainer, Ron White, and many more; and
14	WHEREAS, Robert was blessed to be named Louisiana's Comedian of the Year three
15	years in a row and was discovered by "Shaq's All-Star Comedy Jam" in February 2012 at the
16	first "Shaq's Next All Star Competition"; he toured with the "Shaq All-Star Comedy Jam
17	Tour" in 2012 and 2013; and
