HOUSE BILL NO. 1136

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 26:90(A)(1)(a)(vi) and 286(A)(1)(a)(vi), relative to selling or serving
3 alcoholic beverages; to authorize the use of certain identification cards from another
4 state as acceptable identification for being sold or served alcoholic beverages; and
5 to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 26:90(A)(1)(a)(vi) and 286(A)(1)(a)(vi) are hereby enacted to read
8 as follows:

9 §90. Acts prohibited on licensed premises; suspension or revocation of permits

10 A. No person holding a retail dealer's permit and no agent, associate,
11 employee, representative, or servant of any such person shall do or permit any of the
12 following acts to be done on or about the licensed premises:

13 (1)(a) Sell or serve alcoholic beverages to any person under the age of
14 twenty-one years, unless such person submits any one of the following:

16 (vi) A valid, current, special identification card of another state which
17 contains a photograph of the person and birth date of the person submitting the
18 identification card.

20 §286. Acts prohibited on licensed premises; suspension or revocation of permits

21 A. No person holding a retail dealer's permit and no servant, agent, or
22 employee of the permittee shall do any of the following acts upon the licensed
23 premises:

1 (1)(a) Sell or serve beverages of low-alcoholic content to any person under
2 the age of twenty-one years, unless such person submits any one of the following:

4 (vi) A valid, current, special identification card of another state which
5 contains a photograph of the person and birth date of the person submitting the
6 identification card.
