Claitor (SB 459)

<u>Prior law</u> provided that the DHH secretary or the attorney general may institute a civil action in the courts of this state to seek recovery from persons who violate the Medical Assistance Programs Integrity Law.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>prior law</u>, and further provides that a contract of employment of any private counsel, including fee amounts, and all final fees and costs, shall be a public record.

Effective August 1, 2014.
