1	AN ACT
2	To authorize and provide for certain state property; to authorize the lease of certain state
3	property in Iberville Parish; to authorize the transfer of certain state property in East
4	Baton Rouge Parish; to provide for the property description; to provide for
5	reservation of mineral rights; to provide terms and conditions; to provide an effective
6	date; and to provide for related matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections and the
9	commissioner of administration, notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,
10	are hereby authorized and empowered to lease any interest, excluding mineral rights, the
11	state may have to all or any portion of the following described parcel of property to Barry
12	Smiley:
13	That certain tract or parcel of land together with all building and improvements
14	thereon, and all rights, ways, privileges and prescriptions thereunto belonging, and
15	in anywise appertaining, lying and being situated in Sections 49 and 50, and a small
16	portion in Section 47, Township 9 South, Range 1 East, Southeastern Land District,
17	Iberville Parish, Louisiana. The said tract is situated East of the Mississippi River,
18	and contains 175 acres, more or less, and is bounded now or formerly as follows: On
19	the West by the Mississippi River, on the South and East by the State of Louisiana,
20	for the use of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, and on the North by
21	other lands of Vendors. Said property is more fully shown on the plat of survey
22	prepared by SJB Group, LLC, and shown as "TRACT B, containing 175.000 acres,
23	to be acquired by First Louisiana Resource, LLC."
24	A portion of the above-described property, measuring 467' by 467' is subject to a
25	Lease Agreement, granted for erection and operation of a radio tower, executed by

Frank Polk, et ux, in favor of Waterway Communications System, Inc., dated December 11, 1985, recorded in Conveyance Book 385, Page 77, under Entry No. 28, records Iberville Parish, Louisiana. The Lease provides for an initial term of twenty years commencing on December 11, 1985, and also provides for an extension for an additional period of twenty years under the same terms and conditions. Also, the property is subject to the following rights-of-way: (1) Right-of-way for the U.S. Marine Hospital - Geismer State Highway, Route Nos. 63 and 410, executed by Harry B. Nelson in favor of the state of Louisiana and the Department of Highways, dated July 7, 1941.

Section 2. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections and the commissioner of administration are hereby authorized to enter into such agreements, covenants, conditions, and stipulations and to execute such documents as necessary to properly effectuate any lease, excluding mineral rights, to the property described in Section 1 of this Act, and as more specifically described in any such agreements entered into and documents executed by and between the secretary and the commissioner and Barry Smiley, in exchange of consideration proportionate to the appraised value of the property.

Section 3. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, the deputy secretary of the Office of Juvenile Justice of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, and the division of administration notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, are hereby authorized and empowered to negotiate, convey, transfer, assign, lease, or deliver any interest, excluding mineral rights, the state may have to all or any portion of the following described parcel of property to the City of Baton Rouge, Parish of East Baton Rouge:

Sixty acres of the more or less 854.53 acres to be more definitely designated on the ground situated in Sec 51, 43, 86, 42, & 41, T5S, R1W located at Old Scenic Highway & Groom Road and La. Highway 964 & US Highway 61, Baker, La. 70714 Section 4. The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, the deputy secretary of the Office of Juvenile Justice of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, and the division of administration are hereby authorized to enter into such agreements, covenants, conditions, and stipulations and to execute such documents as necessary to properly effectuate any conveyance, transfer, assignment, lease or delivery of

HB NO. 1085 **ENROLLED** title, excluding mineral rights, to the property described in Section 3 of this Act, and as more specifically described in any such agreements entered into and documents executed by and 3 between the deputy secretary of the Office of Juvenile Justice of the Department of Public 4 Safety and Corrections and the City of Baton Rouge, Parish of East Baton Rouge, in 5 exchange of consideration proportionate to at least the appraised value of the property. Section 5. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not 7 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature 8 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become 10 effective on the day following such approval.
