AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 40:4.9(A)(1)(a) and (B), relative to certain food products prepared in the home for public consumption; to provide for application of the state Sanitary Code; to provide for preparation of cane syrup in the traditional manner for sale; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 40:4.9(A)(1)(a) and (B) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§4.9. Jellies, preserves, jams, honey, honeycomb products, cane syrup, cakes, and cookies; preparation in home for public consumption

A.(1)(a) No provision of the state Sanitary Code or any provision of any other law or regulation that requires any equipment, design, construction, utensils, supplies, preparation, or services shall apply to the preparation of jellies, preserves, jams, honey, honeycomb products, cane syrup, cakes, ~~and or~~ cookies in the home for sale. For purposes of this Section, with respect to preparation of cane syrup, "the home" shall mean, in addition to a dwelling, an open-sided structure on private property that shelters a cast iron kettle, evaporator, or other equipment for preparing cane syrup in the traditional manner. This Section shall not be construed to allow the sale or distribution of any unwholesome food.
