

New law prohibits the manufacture, sale, or possession of any fictitious or facsimile credential that is intended to simulate a valid credential issued by any state, territory, or possession of the U.S., the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, any foreign country or government, a U.S. government-issued credential, or a U.S. passport or foreign government visa. Such valid credentials include any driver's license, driver permit, temporary license, restricted or hardship license, government-issued identification card, school-issued identification card, vehicle registration certificate, or vehicle license plate.

Authorizes the office of motor vehicles to issue a cease and desist order to any person not in compliance with this law. Provides for a procedure for issuance of such order. Also authorizes the office to petition for injunctive relief. Authorizes the promulgation of necessary rules.

Effective August 1, 2014.
