Hill (HB 304) Act No. 10

<u>New law</u> provides for the design, creation, and issuance of the "Louisiana Cattlemen's Association" special prestige license plate provided there is a minimum of 1,000 applicants.

<u>New law</u> provides the license plate shall be issued, upon application, to any citizen of La. in the same manner as any other motor vehicle license plate. Reserves the first 100 plates for purchase at the direction of the La. Cattlemen's Association.

<u>New law</u> provides for the collection of a \$25 royalty fee, as well as a handling fee of \$3.50 for each plate, to be retained by the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to offset a portion of administrative costs.

<u>New law</u> provides that monies collected by the department and forwarded to the La. Cattlemen's Association, or its successor organization, be used solely to coordinate junior cattlemen education and activities and beef promotion and producer education.

Effective August 1, 2014.
