

Existing law (from Act No. 437 of the 2013 R.S.) proposes a constitutional amendment that would require that two of the at-large members of the Wildlife and Fisheries Commission be residents of parishes from north of a line created by the northern boundary of the parishes of Beauregard, Allen, Evangeline, Avoyelles, and Pointe Coupee. The ballot language for such proposed constitutional amendment included an effective date that was not included in the provisions of Act No. 437 of the 2013 R.S.

New law removes the effective date reference from the ballot language.

Effective upon signature of governor (May 7, 2014).
