

Existing law provides procedures for ex parte orders of temporary custody of a minor child and requires the court to allocate time between the parents when an ex parte order is denied.

New law retains existing law and clarifies that the allocation of time occurs at the hearing on the rule to show cause why the respondent should not be awarded the custody, joint custody, or visitation of the child.
