

Prior law provided that the Dept. of State and all the statutory entities made a part of that department by law would terminate their operations on July 1, 2014, and that all legislative authority for such entities would cease as of July 1, 2015, unless the legislature enacted a bill re-creating the department and its statutory entities prior thereto.

New law provides for the general re-creation of the Dept. of State and its statutory entities, effective June 30, 2014, in accordance with the sunset law. Supersedes the provisions of the sunset law which set out the procedure for review and re-creation and which require a separate bill to re-create each statutory entity within the department along with additional provisions. July 1, 2019, is the new termination date, and termination would begin July 1, 2018, unless the department is again re-created.
