

New law provides that the maximum penalty which may be imposed for the violation of any ordinance enacted by the governing authority of the city of New Orleans is a fine of \$500 for a first offense violation and \$1,000 for the second or any subsequent offense. The maximum penalties do not apply to penalties imposed for non-moving or parking violations or other traffic violations, including those captured by an automated traffic enforcement system.
