APPROPRIATIONS/JUDGMENT: Appropriates funds for payment of judgment in the matter of "Zurich American Insurance Company v. Jonathan C. Dark, New Bern Transport Corporation, Gulf Engineers and Consultants, Inc. and the State of Louisiana through the DOTD"

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2015-  
3 2016 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Zurich American  
4 Insurance Company v. Jonathan C. Dark, New Bern Transport Corporation, Gulf  
5 Engineers and Consultants, Inc. and the State of Louisiana through the Department  
6 of Transportation and Development"; and to provide for related matters.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. The sum of Six Thousand Sixty-Two and 50/100 (\$6,062.50) Dollars is  
9 hereby appropriated out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2015-  
10 2016 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Zurich American Insurance  
11 Company v. Jonathan C. Dark, New Bern Transport Corporation, Gulf Engineers and  
12 Consultants, Inc. and the State of Louisiana through the Department of Transportation and  
13 Development", bearing Number 171450, Division "A", on the docket of the Thirty-Second  
14 Judicial District Court, parish of Terrebonne, state of Louisiana.

15 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2015; if vetoed by the governor  
16 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,  
17 2015, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
