SCHOOLS/CHOICE: Provides relative to eligibility requirements for nonpublic schools participating in the voucher program

AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 17:4021(C), to enact R.S. 17:4021(D), and to repeal R.S.
3	17:4021(A)(3), relative to the Student Scholarships for Educational Excellence
4	Program; to provide with respect to nonpublic school eligibility requirements for
5	participation in such program; to provide for exceptions; and to provide for related
6	matters.
7	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
8	Section 1. R.S. 17:4021(C) is hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 17:4021(D)
9	is hereby enacted to read as follows:

12	C.(1) Except as otherwise provided in this Subsection, enrollment of
13	scholarship recipients in a nonpublic participating school that has been approved,
14	provisionally approved, or probationally approved for less than two years shall not
15	exceed twenty percent of such school's total student enrollment.
16	(2) Enrollment of scholarship recipients in a nonpublic participating school
17	that has been approved, provisionally approved, or probationally approved for less
18	than two years may exceed twenty percent of the school's total student enrollment
19	if the department determines that the governing authority of the school has
20	demonstrated a proven record of successful operation as defined by the department

Abstract: Provides for exceptions relative to nonpublic school eligibility requirements for the voucher program.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the Student Scholarships for Excellence Program (voucher program). Provides that to be eligible to participate in the program, a nonpublic school shall meet all of the following criteria:

- (1) Be approved, provisionally approved, or probationally approved by the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) pursuant to present law, R.S. 17:11.
- (2) Comply with the criteria set forth in *Brumfield*, et al. v. Dodd, et al. 425 F. Supp. 528.
- (3) Enrollment of scholarship recipients in a participating school that has been approved, provisionally approved, or probationally approved for less than two years shall not exceed 20% of such school's total enrollment.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that enrollment of scholarship recipients in a nonpublic participating school that has been approved, provisionally approved, or probationally approved for less than two years may exceed 20% of the school's total student enrollment if the department determines that the governing authority of the school has demonstrated a proven record of successful operation and receives a positive recommendation pursuant to an independent evaluation of the governing authority's operations by a third party. Otherwise retains <u>present law</u>.
