1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 49:214.5.2(F), relative to functions and responsibilities of the  
3 Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority Board; to provide for the availability  
4 of certain resources to satisfy mitigation requirements related to integrated coastal  
5 protection projects of the board; and to provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 49:214.5.2(F) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows  
8 §214.5.2. Functions and responsibilities; Coastal Protection and Restoration

**Abstract:** Provides for the functions and responsibilities related to the mitigation of integrated coastal protection projects as approved by the Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority Board.

Present law provides upon the approval by the board, and notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the authority, the state, or any political subdivision thereof, may use its own employees or equipment for satisfying any mitigation requirements resulting from or related to an integrated coastal protection project. Proposed law changes employees or equipment to resources.
