Abstract: Provides for exceptions relative to nonpublic school eligibility requirements for the voucher program.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the Student Scholarships for Excellence Program (voucher program). Provides that to be eligible to participate in the program, a nonpublic school shall meet all of the following criteria:

- (1) Be approved, provisionally approved, or probationally approved by the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) pursuant to <u>present law</u>, R.S. 17:11.
- (2) Comply with the criteria set forth in *Brumfield*, et al. v. Dodd, et al. 425 F. Supp. 528.
- (3) Enrollment of scholarship recipients in a participating school that has been approved, provisionally approved, or probationally approved for less than two years shall not exceed 20% of such school's total enrollment.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that enrollment of scholarship recipients in a nonpublic participating school that has been approved, provisionally approved, or probationally approved for less than two years may exceed 20% of the school's total student enrollment if the department determines that the governing authority of the school has demonstrated a proven record of successful operation and receives a positive recommendation pursuant to an independent evaluation of the governing authority's operations by a third party. Otherwise retains present law.
