

Senate Committee on Judiciary B for the implementation of the sexual assault awareness training no later than July 1, 2016.

Proposed law requires the council to promulgate rules and regulations in accordance with the APA, subject to the oversight of the House Committee on the Administration of Criminal Justice and the Senate Committee on Judiciary B for the implementation of the sexual assault awareness training program for persons employed full-time as college or university police officers no later than Oct. 1, 2015.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Judiciary B to the original bill

1. Changes proposed law homicide investigator training from lead homicide investigator training to POST recognized homicide investigator training.
2. Adds authorization for homicide investigator training programs to include field officer training.
3. Regarding proposed law requirement for appointments to lead investigations in homicide cases, adds authorization for a waiver from homicide investigator training based on prior training or experience as a homicide investigator.
