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Relative to the compensation of a contractor for services performed pursuant to a contractual agreement with an agency

Proposed bill requires any contract entered into by a political subdivision contemplate the variation in the actual size of the project of not more than 15% above or below the estimated size of the project specified within the contract or FEMA Project Worksheet. Proposed law allows either party to demand an equitable adjustment in a contract price. Proposed bill provides that the equitable adjustment is based upon any increase or decrease in costs due solely to the variation above or below 15% of the estimated, contracted size the project.
