A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To commend the Lacassine High School girls' basketball team for winning the Class B state championship.

WHEREAS, the Lacassine High School girls' basketball team completed a sensational 2014-2015 season when they earned the title of Class B state champions after defeating Stanley High School with a final score of 54-43 at Burton Coliseum in Lake Charles; and

WHEREAS, the win against Stanley High School marks the first state championship since 1981 for the Lady Cardinals and the seventh championship title in program history for Lacassine High School; and

WHEREAS, the Lady Cardinals finished the 2014-2015 season with thirty-one wins and five losses, and a 6-0 district record; and

WHEREAS, the Lady Cardinals topped off their season with a thirteen game winning streak; and

WHEREAS, senior Madyson Brasseaux was also named Class B state and District 7-B Most Valuable Player, and she will continue to shine on the basketball court at McNeese State University; and

WHEREAS, head coach Jeremy Hollier was recognized as Class B Coach of the Year and District 7-B Coach of the Year; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to recognize the well-deserved title which the Lady Cardinals have earned, to commend the team for the ability they have displayed, particularly at the most difficult level of competition, and to express sincere and heartfelt congratulations to the team members and the coaching staff for the merits earned and the sportsmanship shown while achieving such a high honor for Lacassine High School.
