Proposed legislation requires that beginning with the 2016-2017 school year, Civics curriculum shall contain a unit of study that includes civics related subject matter knowledge that naturalized citizens are required to demonstrate. Further, that students shall be administered a test based upon the civic portion of the naturalization test used by the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services to survey their knowledge of the history, principles, and form of U.S. government. Requires BESE to promulgate rules to implement the provisions of the proposed legislation. Effective upon governor's signature.
