Proposed bill requires any contract entered into by a political subdivision contemplate the variation in the actual size of the project of not more than 15% above or below the estimated size of the project specified within the contract or FEMA Project Worksheet. Proposed law allows either party to demand an equitable adjustment in a contract price.
