**EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

The proposed legislation will increase expenditures for the statutorily dedicated Crime Victim Reparations Fund in FY 16. This bill requires the LA Commission on Law Enforcement (LCLE) to create a database of all law enforcement officers statewide. LCLE estimates that the creation of this database will cost approximately \$200,000. Estimates by the Office of Technology Services (OTS) for the same database range between \$100,000 and \$150,000. OTS estimates the maintenance costs for this database would total approximately 10% of the initial development cost annually.

Currently, LCLE does not anticipate the need to hire additional personnel to manage this database, however this bill allows LCLE to hire additional personnel as necessary.

**REVENUE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
