10	the Pack program, a mentoring program for first-generation college students at Loyola
11	University; she is active in the Psychology Department and serves as the departmental
12	student representative and the student representative to the College Assembly of the College
13	of Humanities and Natural Sciences; and
14	WHEREAS, Madeline is an Ignatian Scholar and a member of the University Honors
15	Program; she has been on the Dean's List each semester and is a member of Phi Eta Sigma
16	National Honor Society, Psi Chi National Honor Society in Psychology, and Alpha Sigma
17	Nu Jesuit Honor Society; and

1	WHEREAS, Madeline's involvement in the community includes serving as a
2	volunteer for PRIME TIME Family Reading Time, a humanities-focused family literacy
3	program for underserved children and families; she has also volunteered as a tutor for the
4	Start the Adventure in Reading program for second grade students and was named the
5	assistant site coordinator; and
6	WHEREAS, she has also volunteered as a tutor for the Catholic Charities English as
7	a Second Language program and was named a project coordinator for the citywide Martin
8	Luther King, Jr., Day of Service; each year, she volunteers for Loyola's National Day of
9	Community Service, Wolves on the Prowl; and
10	WHEREAS, among her other accomplishments, Madeline has been a member of the
11	Ignacio Volunteers program; during the summer of 2014, she traveled to Belize, Central
12	America, for a three-week immersion service trip and served as a teacher at the Umadagu
13	Lescuela summer camp in the coastal town of Dangriga; and
14	WHEREAS, this summer, Madeline will begin to work on her honors senior thesis
15	in New Orleans studies and will return to Dangriga as a teacher and team leader; and
16	WHEREAS, the Louisiana Legislative Women's Caucus Foundation created the
17	Women of Excellence Awards to recognize and honor extraordinary women of excellence
18	across the state for their outstanding achievements and contributions; and
19	WHEREAS, recipients of the Women of Excellence Awards exhibit characteristics
