1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

- 2 On page 1, line 7, after "liability;" insert "to provide for applicability;"
- 3 AMENDMENT NO. 2
- 4 On page 6, between lines 1 and 2, insert the following:

5 "Section 2. A unilateral amendment or modification by an agent made on or after 6 April 3, 2015, and before the effective date of this Act, to any dealer agreement between a 7 dealer and such agent shall not be effective unless agreed to in writing by the dealer after the 8 effective date of this Act.

9 Section 3. (A) The provisions of this Act shall not apply to any dealer agreement 10 in effect as of the effective date of this Act, unless the dealer agreement does not have an 11 expiration date or such agreement contains a provision giving the agent the unilateral right 12 to amend the terms of the dealer agreement.

(B) If a dealer agreement in effect as of the effective date of this Act is amended or
modified after the effective date of this Act, the provisions of this Act shall apply to the
entirety of the dealer agreement beginning on the date of such amendment or modification."
