5	WHEREAS, state law provides for owners of motor vehicles to show support for a
6	particular organization or philanthropic interest by purchasing a special prestige license
7	plate; and
8	WHEREAS, state law provides for any person with a permanent mobility impairment
9	to purchase a special license plate indicating a mobility impairment; and
10	WHEREAS, state law does not provide for any person with a permanent mobility
11	impairment to show support for any particular organization or philanthropic interest by
12	purchasing a combination mobility impaired special license plate and a speciality prestige
13	license plate; and
14	WHEREAS, state law should provide for the purchase of a combination mobility
15	impaired speciality prestige license plate.
16	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
17	Legislature of Louisiana does hereby urge and request the Department of Public Safety and
18	Corrections, public safety services, to conduct a study relative to the production of a
19	combination mobility impaired specialty prestige license plate.
