AGRICULTURE: Authorizes the Department of Agriculture and Forestry to issue certifications and registrations

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Make a technical change.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Present law defines "commissioner", "department", "encumbrance", "state chemist", and "sustainable" or "sustainable agriculture" for the purposes of present law. Proposed law adds the definitions of "applicant", "person", and "place of business".

Present law authorizes the department, boards, and commissions to issue licenses, permits, and certificates. Proposed law adds authority to issue certifications and registrations. Proposed law adds authority for the department, boards, and commissions issuing licenses, permits, certifications, registrations, or certificates to deny, revoke, or not renew such privileges, if the applicant owes any monies.
