1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 To commend Nathanael P. Kazmierczak on his academic achievements.

3 WHEREAS, Nathanael P. Kazmierczak is the son of Richard and Tamra
4 Kazmierczak; and

5 WHEREAS, on May 23, 2015, Nathanael graduated jointly from Sequitur Classical
6 Academy and from Novus Homeschool Academy, with an unweighted 4.0 grade-point
7 average from both institutions and first in his class at Sequitur; and

8 WHEREAS, while still in high school, Nathanael also served as a substitute teacher
9 at Sequitur Classical Academy, teaching Algebra 2 and drawing classes during periods of
10 teacher absence or illness; and

11 WHEREAS, Nathanael's senior thesis, "Restoring the Creeds: How Standards of
12 Faith Promote Spiritual and Intellectual Growth", was successfully defended, received
13 honors for the best senior thesis and defense, and has been submitted for publication by Mud
14 House Art and Literature; and

15 WHEREAS, Nathanael received a perfect composite score of 36 on the American
16 College Test (ACT), a perfect composite score of 2400 on the Scholastic Aptitude Test
17 (SAT), perfect scores of 800 on the SAT Mathematics Level 2 Subject Test and on the SAT
18 Literature Subject Test; and

1 WHEREAS, Nathanael has chosen to attend Calvin College in Grand Rapids,
2 Michigan, where he has been offered six separate scholarships, including a National Merit
3 Scholarship, the Howard Hughes Medical Institute Scholarship for research, the F.F. Carl
4 Heule Sr. Scholarship, the Llewellyn L. Cayvan String Instrument Scholarship, the Carol
5 Lee Zylstra Memorial Church Music Scholarship, and the Coram Deo Award awarded for
6 service potential; and

7 WHEREAS, Nathanael will pursue a double major in chemistry and music; and

8 WHEREAS, in addition to his many academic accomplishments, Nathanael is a
9 classical guitarist who enjoys playing for groups as varied as retirement home residents and
10 for his youth group at the South Baton Rouge Church of Christ, and also is an avid tennis
11 player; and

12 WHEREAS, Nathanael hopes to pursue a career as a professional research chemist
13 after completing graduate school; and

14 WHEREAS, it is appropriate to commend and congratulate Nathanael upon these
15 many accomplishments.

16 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
17 commend Nathanael P. Kazmierczak on his academic accomplishments, and does hereby
18 extend to him best wishes for his continued success in his future endeavors.
