Amendments proposed by House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs to Reengrossed Senate Bill No. 250 by Senator Johns

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "To" insert "amend and reenact R.S. 44:4.1(B)(19) and to"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 7, after "penalties;" insert "to provide for certain prohibitions; to provide for  
5 an exception from the Public Records Law;"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 5, line 23, after "I.(1)" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 24 through  
8 28 and at the beginning of line 29, delete "(2)"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 4

10 On page 6, line 3, change "(3)" to "(2)"

11 AMENDMENT NO. 5

12 On page 6, line 6, change "(4)" to "(3)"

13 AMENDMENT NO. 6

14 On page 6, line 10, change "(5)" to "(4)"

15 AMENDMENT NO. 7

16 On page 6, line 11, after "system" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 12 and  
17 13, and insert a comma "," and the following:

18 "except data retained as evidence of a violation of compulsory motor vehicle  
19 insurance law or a felony being investigated, shall be exempt from the Public  
20 Records Law."

21 AMENDMENT NO. 8

22 On page 6, between lines 13 and 14, insert the following:

23 "(5) Under no circumstances shall a law enforcement agency,  
24 other entity, or other person use an automated license plate recognition  
25 system or any data collected, retained, or shared through such system to  
26 enforce civil traffic citations by any method including towing or booting  
27 or other immobilization method of a motor vehicle."

28 AMENDMENT NO. 9

29 On page 6, after line 16, insert the following:

30 "J. Except for the provisions of Paragraph (I)(5) of this Section, the  
31 provisions of this Part shall apply only to law enforcement agencies, other  
32 entities, and authorized users and shall not apply to or be construed or

1 **interpreted in a manner to prohibit the use of any other automated license plate**  
2 **recognition system by an individual or private legal entity for purposes not**  
3 **otherwise prohibited by law.**

4 "Section 2. R.S. 44:4.1(B)(19) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

5 §4.1. Exceptions

6 \* \* \*

7 B. The legislature further recognizes that there exist exceptions, exemptions,  
8 and limitations to the laws pertaining to public records throughout the revised  
9 statutes and codes of this state. Therefore, the following exceptions, exemptions, and  
10 limitations are hereby continued in effect by incorporation into this Chapter by  
11 citation:
