Purpose of Bill: Would change the entity name from "Lafayette Parish Bayou Vermilion District" to "Bayou Vermilion District". Would allow the district to undertake any work it deems necessary to improve water quality and to remove obstructions to natural water flow in Bayou Vermilion within Lafayette Parish and Bayou Carencro.
