Existing law provides for the use of electronic surveillance equipment pursuant to a court order.

Existing law limits the use of such equipment to "law enforcement or investigative officers" and defines those as:

- (1) Any commissioned officer of the office of state police.
- (2) Any full-time commissioned city police officer of a municipality of this state.
- (3) Any sheriff or deputy sheriff of a parish of this state.

New law retains existing law and adds the attorney general or an attorney general's investigator to the list of law enforcement officers who can obtain a court order authorizing the use of electronic surveillance equipment.

Effective August 1, 2015.
