

## **RÉSUMÉ DIGEST**

**ACT 71 (HB 350)**

**2015 Regular Session**

Existing law provides that any person who qualifies to run for the office of justice of the peace or constable after 2008 shall not have attained the age of 70 years by the date of qualification, and that any justice of the peace or constable who attains 70 years of age while serving a term of office shall be allowed to complete that term of office.

New law exempts persons who are serving or already elected to serve as constable or justice of the peace on Aug. 15, 2006, from all age requirements to serve or run for their offices in the future.

Effective August 1, 2015.
