<u>Existing law</u> defines "commissioner", "department", "encumbrance", "state chemist", and "sustainable" or "sustainable agriculture" for the purposes of existing law.

New law adds the definitions of "applicant", "person", and "place of business".

 $\underline{\text{Existing law}}$ authorizes the department, boards, and commissions to issue licenses, permits, and certificates.

New law adds authority to issue certifications and registrations.

<u>New law</u> adds authority for the department, boards, and commissions issuing licenses, permits, certifications, registrations, or certificates to deny, revoke, or not renew such privileges, if the applicant owes any monies.
