5 WHEREAS, Mr. Peters was born on March 2, 1955, in Bogalusa; and

6 WHEREAS, he attended Wesley Ray High School; as a young man living in the
7 country, Mr. Peters milked cows, worked in the cotton fields, and picked corn and peas; and

8 WHEREAS, on February 3, 1974, he married Kathy E. Peters; they are the proud
9 parents of Cheryl R. Peters Walker, Tammy R. Peters, Marlon J. Peters, and Willie B. Peters,
10 III; they also have sixteen grandchildren and one great-granddaughter; and

6 accomplishments and for the tremendous joy that he brings to all who know and love him.
